SCHOOL REFERRAL PROGRAM

Program Philosophy:

Experience has taught us the word-of-mouth is one of the best methods of connecting prospective families to Saint Luke. We want to reward families with children currently enrolled at Saint Luke who choose to play an active role in supporting the mission of Saint Luke.

Program Description:

Families with a student(s) currently enrolled at Saint Luke can receive a \$250 tuition credit for every new family they refer to Saint Luke who enrolls one or more students in grades K-8.

Program Details:

In order for the referring family to receive the \$250 credit, the new family must:

- 1. Complete and submit one signed New Family Referral Card with their registration.
- 2. Register and enroll at least one student in grades K-8.
- 3. Be enrolled at least for two trimesters at Saint Luke, remaining current with tuition payments during the period. (The tuition credit will be applied after the first two trimesters are completed.)

The \$250 credit applies toward the 2024-2025 tuition and will be fully credited in March of 2025. (After two trimesters of attendance have been completed), provided both the new family and the referring family are current with their tuition payments at the end of the 2nd trimester.

There is no limit to the amount of tuition credits that a currently enrolled Saint Luke family can earn by referring new families. If the total amount of credits should exceed the family's 2024-2025 tuition bill, the excess tuition credit will be applied toward its 2024-2025 tuition bill.

In this Christian community, it is our hope that a spirit of honesty will prevail throughout the entire process. This program is intended to attract new families who are not enrolled at Saint Luke presently. Please implement this program in the way that it is intended.

Referring families may choose to assign/give the \$250 credit to the new family that they referred. We hope this program will encourage Saint Luke families to seek out friends, neighbors and associates who will explore Saint Luke as an option for their children.
