The Parent Participation Program (PPP) provides a process for school families to contribute service hours to the school ministry program as it seeks to do God's Will.

Saint Luke Lutheran School values parental involvement in the education of children as well as in the entire program of the school and congregation. Working together as parents, staff and congregation, a positive school environment and community spirit will be enhanced. Parent participation will also benefit the education, safety and well being of the students, staff and families of Saint Luke. Service hours and/or monies also provide improvements to the school facility, support for maintenance needs and complete tasks that may otherwise be done by paid workers. Each family is asked to make a commitment of time, talents or treasures to Saint Luke's program.

- All families are requested to provide a minimum of 10 service hours annually.
  - A list of suggested opportunities for service can be found on the backside of your service hour log sheet (enclosed).
  - Service hours will be recorded and maintained by each family and their service hour log needs to be completed and turned in by May 1.

(More than 10 hours will be gladly accepted but cannot be carried over to the following school year.)
