The Parent Participation Program (PPP) provides a process for school families to contribute service hours to the school ministry program as it seeks to do God's Will.

Parent participation will also benefit the education, safety and well being of the students, staff and families of Saint Luke. Each family is asked to make a commitment of time, talents or treasures to Saint Luke's program.

- **All families are requested to provide a minimum of 10 service hours annually.**

- **Service hours will be recorded and maintained by each family and their service hour log needs to be completed and turned in by May 1.**
